As part of the research project <u>ELEMENT</u>, this PhD project will examine if, why and how the EC/EU established itself as an influential actor in environmental issues using the case study of water protection. In particular, the project aims to analyse the EC/EU's efforts to improve water quality in environmental terms to assess whether and how it became a major player in this field. The project will analyse the EC/EU's standing vis-à-vis the member states, while also placing the EC/EU in a global context. The project will explore changes of governance and policy instruments along with the involvement and interactions of different institutional, societal, and economic actors.
