History of Presence

Presence is not among the basic concepts of historical scholarship; it is as ubiquitous as it is invisible. With a focus on recent history, this project asks how presence can be made useful for historical analysis, and what analytic potential a concept of regimes of presence has. This project receives special support from a Distinguished Fellowship of the Max Weber Centre for Advanced Cultural and Social Studies at the University of Erfurt, which Kiran Klaus Patel will hold in the winter term 2021/22.
